This job is for a young person who lives with a disability.

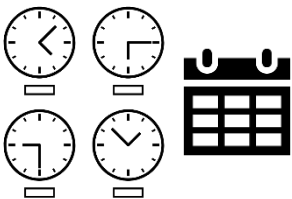
You will work as a Peer Mentor with our project staff.

You will use your lived experience to help young students living with disability.

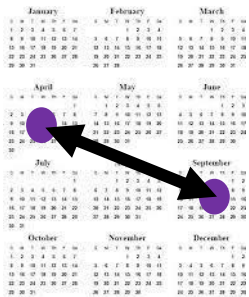


This is a casual, paid job.

- Be able to arrive at workshops and training on time.

Be willing to attend training sessions

- Attend Mentor training sessions.
- Attend Child Safe Environments Training.
- Apply for a Working With Children Check.
